Course Description:

Learn a proven incident management system for emergencies, disasters or events. Students will be introduced to an effective system for command, control and coordination of response to and at an incident/event site. The Incident Command System (ICS) is recognized as a standardized on-site management system designed to enable effective, efficient incident management by integrating combination of facilities, equipment, personnel, procedures and communications operating within a common organizational structure.

ICS is used to manage an incident or non-emergency event, and can be used equally well for both small and large situations.

This course includes Introduction to ICS – I100 (the first of a series of ICS training courses) and Intermediate ICS – I300 and will be of particular interest to first responders and those who have a support role in an Incident Command Post (ICP) or Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Course Goal:

The purpose of this course is to provide students with a general understanding of the Incident Command System, Command & General Staff functions and responsibilities, the planning process and its role in supporting and effective resource management during an incident/event.

Objectives of the course:

Prepare to coordinate with all response partners from all levels, jurisdictions and private sector. in resource and incident management
